SPECIAL ELECTIONS

City of Farmington: An Election to be held to determine whether licenses will be granted for the manufacture or sale or bartering, loaning, or giving away of intoxicating liquor in the city of Farmington.

City of Greenland: An election to be held to determine whether licenses will be granted for the manufacture or sale or bartering, loaning, or giving away of intoxicating liquor in the city of Greenland.

City of Elkins: Four (4) year Alderman terms

Vote for or against electing aldermen for each ward in the City of Elkins for four (4) year terms to begin with half of those aldermen elected at the general election held in November 2018 and to begin with the other half of the aldermen elected at the general election in 2020.

City of West Fork: Vacancy for Mayor

STATE ISSUES

ISSUE NO. 1: Proposing an Amendment to the Arkansas Constitution concerning the terms, election, and eligibility of Elected Officials

ISSUE NO. 2: A Constitutional Amendment to allow the Governor to retain his or her powers and duties when absent from the State.

ISSUE NO. 3: An Amendment to the Arkansas Constitution concerning job creation, job expansion, and economic development.

ISSUE NO. 4: An Amendment to limit attorney contingency fees and non-economic damages in medical lawsuits
